

Sam Houston Area Council Tour Plan Guide

You **DO NOT** need a Tour Plan, but must follow policies in The Guide to Safe Scouting for:

1. Day Trips **within** the Sam Houston Area Council boundaries
2. Any Sam Houston Area Council or Sam Houston Area Council District Sponsored Events, this includes Camporees, Scout Fair, Day Camp, etc.
3. Trips outside the Sam Houston Area Council boundaries to Sam Houston Area Council owned property. (El Rancho Cima)

You **DO** need a Tour Plan for:

1. Day Trips **outside** of Sam Houston Area Council boundaries
2. Any overnight trip not on Sam Houston Area Council owned property (State Parks, Lock-ins, etc)
3. Trips of 500 miles or more from the Sam Houston Area Council boundaries
4. Trips to any National High-Adventure Base, National Scout jamboree, National Order of the Arrow Conference (NOAC), or B.S.A. regionally sponsored event.
5. When conducting, as a unit, any of the following activities not sponsored by the Sam Houston Area Council or its districts:
 - a. Aquatics activities (swimming, boating, floating, scuba, etc)
 - b. Climbing and rappelling
 - c. Orientation flights (see flying plan)
 - d. Shooting sports (rifle, shotgun, archery)
 - e. Any activities involving motorized vehicles as part of the program
(snowmobiles, boating, etc)
