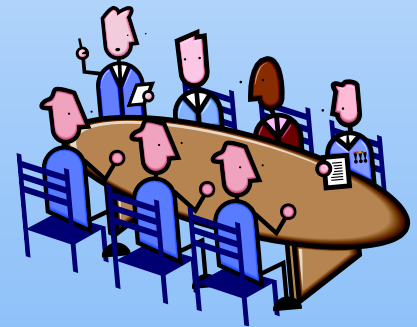

What to Pack



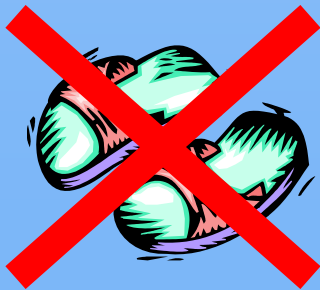
- Water bottle – continuous hydration is key at this elevation

- Spending money
 - ✓ meals at airport
 - ✓ Souvenirs
 - ✓ Camp trading posts
 - ✓ Some merit badges require nominal fee



What **NOT** to Pack

- NO open toed sandals for walking around camp
- No Poker chips; playing cards are o.k.
- Do Not bring food/candy to store in your tent or backpack during the week
 - ✓ Snacks are available at the Trading Post



Airplane Carry-on/backpack

- Review TSA Requirements for your carry-on/backpack
- Backpack/carry-on must fit in overhead or under seat
- **DO NOT bring pocket knives on airplane** – pack in your gear for the trailer
- Pack any medications in your carry-on; not in trailer
- Bring a book to read during travel
- iPods, Game Boys are o.k. during travel only. Not to be used at camp and the scout is responsible for it at all times.
- Packing a change of clothing is not necessary. We will meet up with trailer later in the day.
